

English AG activities.

1. Presentation

Prepare a 5 to 10 minute presentation on either:

- a hero - music, sport, fashion designer, etc- or a family member
- a country or town you know and love – make us want to visit it!

Use this format:

- Introduce yourself and the topic – tell us what you are going to tell us...!
- The main body of the presentation – tell us...!
- Summary – tell us what you have told us...!
- ask audience for questions – if you are audience, think of questions whilst listening.

Use “Useful Language for Presentations” sheet to find phrases to link ideas.

We want you to give your presentation to the group when we meet again.

DON'T just read it as a text – write it as a text for us to mark the English but, for the actual presentation, make notes and refer to them only as memory aids.

LOOK at the audience, **USE** your hands and body language to keep us interested, **USE** pictures, photos, souvenirs, etc.

2. CREATURE QUIZ

Choose a creature – animal, bird, insect, sea-creature - and write short descriptive sentences about it. We have to guess what it is.

What does it look like?

What does it eat? What eats it?!?

Where does it live?

e.g. “My creature has got X legs/wings/horns/flippers. Its skin is scaly/covered in fur...

It eats plants/ants/humans and lives in the forest/bottom of the sea/Friedrichshain...

What is it?”

3. DISCUSSION

1. Look at the “OPINIONS, FEELINGS, DISCUSSION TOPICS” sheet.

2. Choose one of the six sets of question, think about them and write your opinion/answers...because we're going to discuss them when we see you again!
